

NAME

`musixflx` – process `mx1` files (the second pass of 3-pass MusiXTeX typesetting)

SYNOPSIS

```
[ texlua ] musixflx[.lua] jobname [ .mx1 | .tex ] [ debugmode ]
```

where *debugmode* can be

d	output debugging information to the screen
m	output line numbers to the screen
f	output debugging information to <code>jobname.mx1</code> (not <code>mx1</code>)
s	output computed lines to the screen

DESCRIPTION

`Musixflx` processes `mx1` files (the second pass of 3-pass MusiXTeX typesetting)

To allow for ease of use with a batch file, **`musixflx.lua`** can be fed with either *jobname.mx1*, *jobname.tex*, or just *jobname*, any of which open *jobname.mx1* and create *jobname.mx2*.
